
# Mystery Quilt 2022 - Block 2

Welcome to Block 2 of our Mystery Quilt 2022
Great job yesterday.

## For Block 2, you will need:

- 1 light blue fabric
- 1 dark blue fabric
- <u>Creative Grids® ALASKA Ruler</u> -or- <u>Mystery Templates B and C</u>

Cutting Directions:



#### Begin by cutting strips:

- Dark blue fabric 2 strips 3½" x 20"
- Light blue fabric 4 strips 3½" x 20"

#### <u>Cutting with Creative Grids® ALASKA Ruler</u>:



Align your ruler and cut.

From one strip of dark blue fabric, you should be able to get 8 pieces. Cut both strips for a total of 16 dark blue pieces.


Align your ruler and cut.


From one strip of light blue fabric, you should be able to get 4 pieces. Cut 4 strips for a total of 16 light blue pieces.

# Alternative way of cutting with the Mystery Templates B and C:

Use your Template B to cut your pieces from the dark blue fabric strips as showing in the picture. Cut 16 pieces.







### ${\sf Block\,Assembly}$

Edyta's Tip: Keep your ruler or templates handy after cutting.

They are the perfect tool to help you precisely mark your sewing points.







Lay and pin them right sides together.



Then sew blocks together using chain sewing.




Press your seam open and use your template A or ruler to trim.
